Welcome to Cornerstone!

Last week we looked at Jesus' promise to send the Holy Spirit. Today we see what that means in practice for Christians: How we take hold of the voice of the Spirit; How we should pray for the Spirit; and how we should stir up the gifts of the Spirit.

Luke 11:1-13 One day Jesus was praying in a certain place. When he finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught his disciples." ² He said to them, "When you pray, say: 'Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come.' ³ Give us each day our daily bread. ⁴ Forgive us our sins, for we also forgive everyone who sins against us. And lead us not into temptation.' " ⁵ Then he said to them, "Suppose one of you has a friend, and he goes to him at midnight and says, 'Friend, lend me three loaves of bread, ⁶ because a friend of mine on a journey has come to me, and I have nothing to set before him.' ⁷ "Then the one inside answers, 'Don't bother me. The door is already locked, and my children are with me in bed. I can't get up and give you anything.' ⁸ I tell you, though he will not get up and give him the bread because he is his friend, yet because of the man's boldness he will get up and give him as much as he needs. ⁹ "So I say to you: Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. ¹⁰ For everyone who asks receives; he who seeks finds; and to him who knocks, the door will be opened. ¹¹ "Which of you fathers, if your son asks for a fish, will give him a snake instead? ¹² Or if he asks for an egg, will give him a scorpion? ¹³ If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!"

**Media Wisdom & Media Influence
on Today's Culture: Triumphant
Over Our Greatest Challenge:** Our

influence of the mass media of
entertainment on our children and
grandchildren. The media, for good
and for ill, is the primary teacher of
our youth. There's hope though –
children can be taught to be media-
wise, and the entertainment industry
can be turned toward the

good, the true, and the beautiful. This featured seminar enables you to teach children to be media-wise, helps you understand the wide influence of the mass media, and shows you how to redeem the industry.

The Media's Influence on Different Stages of Development: During each stage of cognitive development, children react differently to entertainment media. To help them develop media wisdom, it is critically important to understand how children perceive the mass media at each stage and how best to help them learn to use – and not abuse – the media. The second step is to understand their susceptibility during each stage of development, since each child is susceptible to different stimuli. This seminar will explore those stages and explain how to help children become media-wise at each stage.

An account of Revival, by Welsh Preacher Samuel Davies in 1757



About sixteen years ago, in the northern colonies, when all religious concern was much out of fashion, and the generality lay in a dead sleep in sin, having at best but the form of godliness—but nothing of the power; when the country was in peace and prosperity, free from the calamities of war, and epidemic sickness; when, in short, there were no extraordinary calls to repentance; then suddenly, a deep, general concern about eternal things spread through the country; sinners, startled out of their slumbers—broke off from their vices, began to cry out, *What shall I do to be saved?* and made it the great business of their life to prepare for the world to come. Then the gospel seemed almighty, and carried all before it. It pierced the very hearts of men with an irresistible power. I have seen thousands at once melted down under it; all eager to hear as for life, and hardly a dry eye to be seen among them!
