Media Wisdom & Media Influence on Today's Culture: Triumphant Over Our Greatest Challenge: Our greatest challenge now is the influence of the mass media of entertainment on our children and grandchildren. The media, for good and for ill, is the primary

teacher of our youth. There's hope though – children can be taught to be media-wise, and the entertainment industry can be turned to turned toward the good, the true, and the beautiful. This featured seminar enables you to teach children to be media-wise, helps you understand the wide influence of the mass media, and shows you how to redeem the industry. The Media's Influence on Different Stages of Development: During each stage of cognitive development, children react differently to entertainment media. To help them develop media wisdom, it is critically important to understand how children perceive the mass media at each stage and how best to help them learn to use – and not abuse – the media. The second step is to understand their susceptibility during each stage of development, since each child is susceptible to different stimuli. This seminar will explore those stages and explain how to help children become media-wise at each stage.

The Golden Rule

From *J. C. Ryle*, "The Gospel of Matthew" 1856)

"So in everything, do to others what you would have them do to you." Matt. 7:12

Jesus here lays down a general principle for our guidance in all doubtful questions between man and man.

We are not to deal with others as others deal with us. This is mere selfishness and heathenism.

We are to deal with others as we would like others to deal with us. This is real Christianity.

This is a golden rule indeed! It does not merely forbid all petty malice and revenge, all cheating and deceit. It does much more. **It settles a hundred difficult points**, which in a world like this are continually arising between man and man.

It prevents the necessity of laying down endless little rules for our conduct in specific cases. It sweeps the whole debatable ground with one mighty principle. It shows us a balance and measure, by which every one may see at once what is his duty.

Is there a thing we would not like our neighbor to do to us? Then let us always remember, that this is the thing we ought not to do to him.

Is there a thing we would like him to do to us? Then this is the very thing we ought to do to him.

How many intricate questions would be decided at once, if this rule were honestly used!
